## **Annual General Meeting of the Association**

**Proposal to build houses on land to the South of Penn Road** The application to build houses on the land to the south of Penn Road which was withdrawn about year ago, has been resubmitted (Application No.11/00980/OUT). Although this is an outline application, it will settle important aspects of the development such as scale, layout and access. Although the new application includes numerous small changes, the general thrust remains the same. It is still for 48 dwellings and the access would involve traffic to and from the development going all the way along Penn Road. Objections need to be in by 12 June. Even if you miss the date by a few days, it is still worth writing a letter.

**Bus Pass Availability** Although it has not been widely advertised, the rules for over-60s and disabled people's bus passes have changed. From 22 May, it is no longer possible to use them in Milton Keynes before 0930. They have thus fallen back into line with their general availability in other areas. In the evening they can still be used after 2300, when the national scheme stops. (That is your reward for staying up late and finding a bus which actually runs after 2300!)
